UPDATE: In July Olympic National Park released a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the <u>Emergency Action to Temporarily Relocate the</u> <u>Enchanted Valley Chalet</u>. Monroe House Moving of Sequim, Wash., a principle advocate for the action, was selected as the contractor in a non-competitive award. The work is scheduled to be completed before the fall rains.

No cost for the project was specified, but it was stated that funds would come from the park's (already-strapped) operating budget. Visitors should prepare for fewer visitor services, reduced trail, road and campground maintenance—and a boarded-up chalet on blocks in lovely Enchanted Valley.
